To All Signatory Contractors,

The members of Local 797 have voted to allocate the negotiated increase. The following allocation is to be **effective as of July 1, 2023**.

PLASTERERS

It was voted on and approved to allocate the \$2.20 as follows for the Plasterers: **\$1.83 to the** Wage, **\$0.15 to Supplemental Dues**, **\$0.02 to International Dues**, **\$0.15 to the Pension**, and **\$0.05 to Local Training**.

CEMENT MASONS

It was voted on and approved to allocate the \$2.15 as follows for the Cement Masons: \$1.00 to the Wage, \$0.43 to the Vacation, \$0.15 to Supplemental Dues, \$0.02 to International Dues, \$0.50 to the Pension, and \$0.05 to Local Training.
