This experience led Madison back to community college, where she pursued a career in the skilled trades at Laney College in Oakland, CA.

Madison completed her 5-year Apprenticeship program with District Council 16 Northern California Architectural Metal & Glass Workers. Over her 13 years in the field, Madison served as a Superintendent, Foreman, and Leadman. She had the opportunity to learn and be mentored by some of the most skilled mechanics and caring mentors in the industry.

In the last decade, Madison has continued her career path as a Union leader, community activist, and advocate for careers in non-traditional employment.
