At a meeting held on June 27, 2024, the members of Local 797 voted to ratify the negotiated changes to the Master Labor Agreement. The members also voted to allocate the negotiated first year increase. The following allocation is to be **effective as of July 1, 2024**.

It was voted on and approved to allocate the \$3.00 as follows for the Plasterers: \$2.00 to the Wage, \$0.15 to Supplemental Dues, \$0.03 to International Dues, \$0.25 to the Health & Welfare, \$0.50 to the Pension, \$0.06 to the Local Training, and \$0.01 to the International Training.
